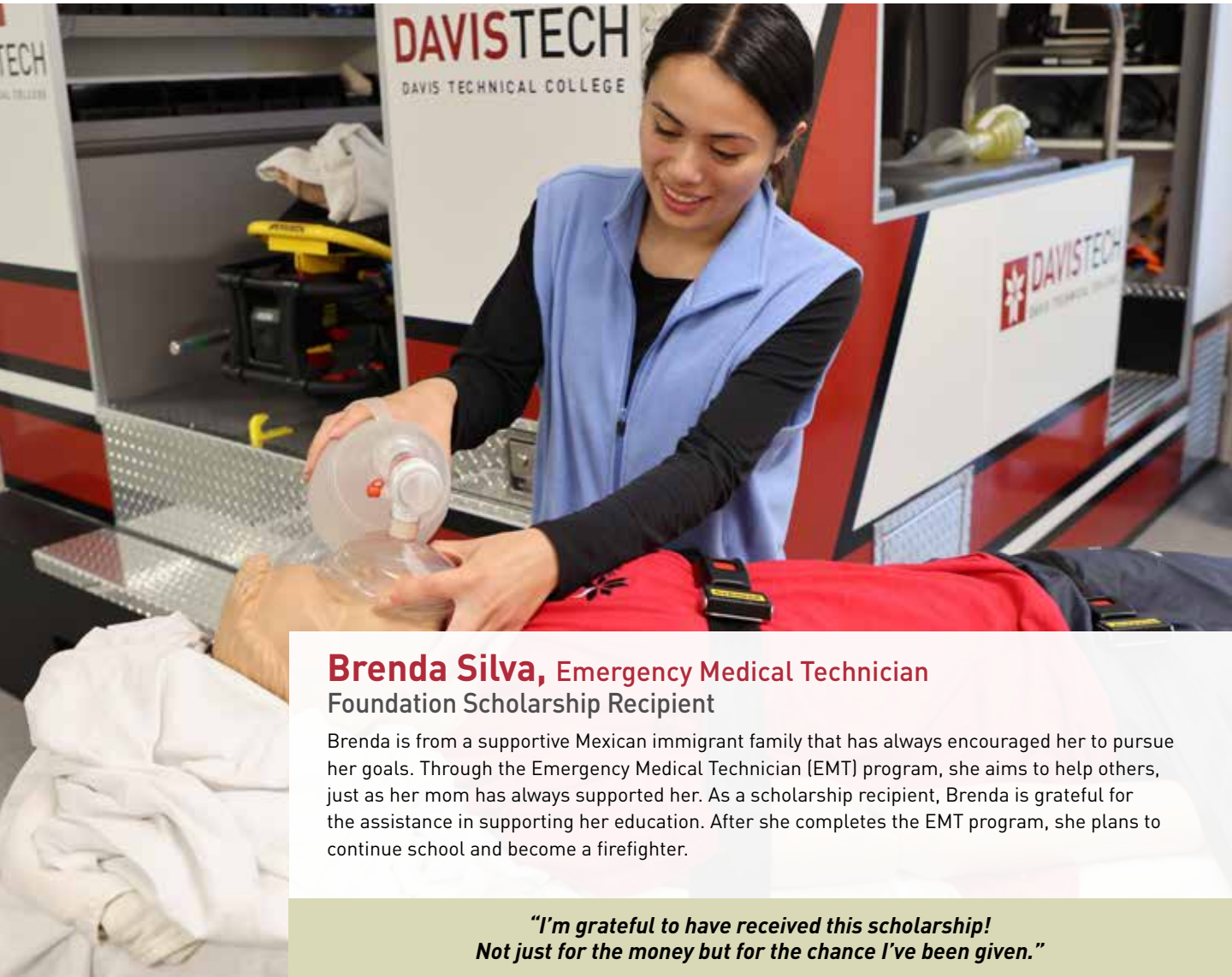

SkillsUSA and HOSA Competitions



The Foundation provided \$22,500 to help support the cost of 30 Davis Tech students attending the national SkillsUSA and HOSA competitions. Veteran and Welding Technology student Steven Moon took Silver in the Welding Sculpture event at the SkillsUSA competition in Atlanta, GA, in June 2023. While visiting the Foundation Board to tell about his time at SkillsUSA, he emphasized the exciting opportunities he had to learn and network. Steven has completed his training in the Welding program and recently graduated from Davis Tech. He currently teaches forging classes and produces blades and knives.
